Following our first Celebrate gathering last November since the start of the pandemic, the A+D Museum has been hard at work bringing a range of tours and programming to the LA community.

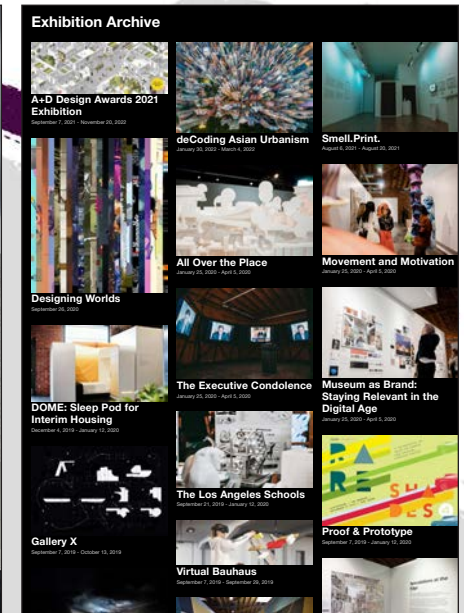
